In May 22 2013, Lee Rigby a British soldier in the Royal Army Fussillers was brutally murdered at the Woolwich Barack by two-self-proclaimed black Islamists.

These attacks are seen as a heightened reaction, graver than since the London bombings in 2005.

This led to an escalatation of an anti-muslim assaults across the UK, causing the government to address the issue of rising Islamophobia in the country.

We will look at the largest Muslim ethnic group, their Pakistanis, who have long assimilated in UK but are not seen to have integrated into an environment so susceptible to a racial tension.

We will also feature views from native British citizens who have learnt to accept Muslims and feel at ease with living amongst them.

This documentary will try to portray the views from two sides of the equation and bring forth some answers to the growing concern of Islamophobia.
